# Last Day to Donate to Haiti

Pastor Thomas Bernard contacted us recently and asked us if we could help the saints at Good Shepherd in Haiti with a project. Because Haiti is such an impoverished country, and because the infrastructure for their electrical grid is so unreliable, they are requesting assistance in purchasing solar panels, batteries, and an inverter to be installed at Good Shepherd Lutheran Church and School.

Pastor Bernard shared that over 50% of the people in Haiti do not have electricity. Of those who do, there are frequent brown outs and power outages. It is not uncommon for Good Shepherd to go days or weeks without power.

The school is trying to educate their students so they can break the poverty cycle. And they are using computers in their education process. Often, when the power is out, they can't access the computers.

Also, while they can have Sunday worship with or without electricity, when they have services planned during the week in the evening, no power means they often must cancel services. Pastor Bernard said that the members are already depressed with the political unrest and the economic stress, but when they can't worship and find comfort in Christ together, the anxiety gets worse. And we know that the light of Jesus makes all the difference!

The Heart for Haiti board considers this a worthwhile project and are kicking off **"Watt a Difference the Son Makes"** – a fundraiser for the purchase of the solar panels and equipment. The project will cost \$10,000.

We pray you will prayerfully consider participating in this campaign that will be open through Lent and end Easter Sunday!
